



The NSS Special Camp for the academic year 2025–26 was organized by the MMIT NSS Unit Cell in association with Savitribai Phule Pune University **from 24th January to 30th January 2026 at Vadhu Khurd, Taluka Haveli, Pune, which is 21 km from the MMIT campus.** The camp consisted of 53 members, including staff and students. The camp was conducted under the guidance of Dr. R. V. Bhortake, Principal of Matathwada Mitramandal Institute of Technology, Lohgaon, Pune, and was coordinated by Prof. R. P. Polas, NSS Program Officer, along with Mr. Kishor Kale, Dr. A. G. Pal, Prof. M. D. Bhise, and Prof. Swapnil Gagare, NSS Program Coordinators of the MMIT NSS Unit Cell. The main aim of the camp was to help the villagers, understand their lifestyle, assist them in improving their skills, provide technical knowledge wherever possible, and create awareness among them about Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, tree plantation, the Digital India campaign, voter awareness, cyber fraud awareness, and health awareness programs. Day 1 (24/01/2026)





Day 2 (25/01/2026)

The second day of the NSS Special Camp began at 6:00 a.m. with a wake-up call for all volunteers. 

The session concluded with the recitation of the National Integration Pledge, NSS Anthem, SPPU Anthem, and the National Anthem. 
